***Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, Year C, 14 April 2019***

*Reading 1:* Isaiah 50.4-7; *Psalm* 22.7-8, 16-17, 18-19, 22-23 [R. 1]

*Reading 2:* Philippians 2.6-11; *Gospel:* Luke 22.14 - 23.56

**CCC Paragraph 613:** Christ's death is both the *Paschal sacrifice* that accomplishes the definitive redemption of all, through "*the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world*", and the *sacrifice of the New Covenant*, which restores us to communion with God by reconciling us to God through the "*blood of the covenant, which was poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins*". [Matthew 26:28; cf. Exodus 24:8; Leviticus 16:15-16; 1 Corinthians 11:25].

**Prayer:** God of Life, you know intimately how much we need you and each other. Break down our resistance to our own needs. Help us to embrace our need for you and one another. ### The God of Life needs...

Right at the beginning of the Passion, in giving instructions to the disciples for the Passover, Jesus says something curious: If anyone questions you about the donkey, tell them, "*The Lord needs it.*" [Luke 19]. The instructions are practical, but they point to something throughout the Passion reading that follows. Jesus needs things, and people. Our God, who is all powerful, chooses to experience human need. Jesus needs a donkey. He needs His friends. He needs a drink. He needs to reach out to the man on the next cross.

All too often we consider our own needs a result of weakness, but needing each other is part of how we are created in God's image. This Holy Week, embrace the ways you need God & His people. Attendees will be asked to bring baby food to give to Winnipeg Harvest. People will be reminded to check the expiry date.

**Collection of plastics at all diocesan conventions. BAG-UP MANITOBA:** the CWL Manitoba Provincial Council has asked us to also collect plastic items. It is from MMSM's Bag Up Manitoba Schools where children collect plastics and then they are sent to Ontario to make recycled park benches, planters, birdhouses and feeders. Those items accepted are retail bags, newspaper sleeves, produce bags, bread bags, ice bags, bubble wrap, pellet bags, salt bags, dry cleaning bags, re-sealable food bags (Ziploc), cereal bags, bags from toilet paper or paper towels, bags from cases of pop, potato chip and candy bags. Items not accepted are pet food bags, bags or wrap from meat, soiled bags.
