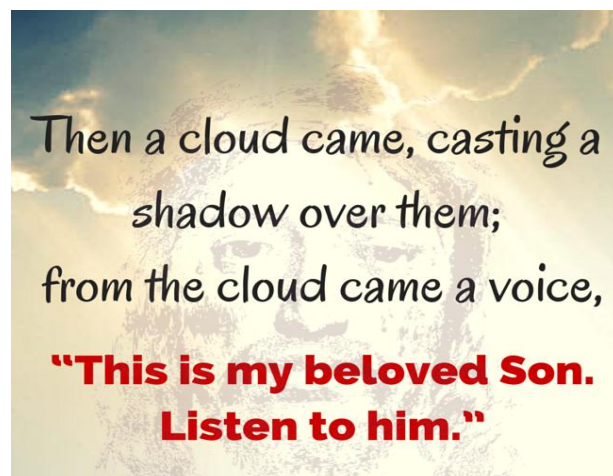

Second Sunday of Lent, Year C, 17 March 2019

Reading 1: Genesis 15.5-12, 17-18; Psalm 27.1, 7-8, 9, 13-14 [R.1a]

Reading 2: Philippians 3.17 - 4.1; Gospel: Luke 9.28b-36

CCC Paragraph 554: From the day Peter confessed that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, the Master "began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things. . . and be killed, and on the third day be raised." [Matthew 16:21]. Peter scorns this prediction, nor do the others understand it any better than he. In this context the mysterious episode of Jesus' **Transfiguration** takes place on a high mountain, before three witnesses chosen by himself: Peter, James and John. Jesus' face and clothes become dazzling with light, and Moses and Elijah appear, speaking "of his departure, which he was to accomplish at Jerusalem". [Luke 9:31]. A cloud covers him and a voice from heaven says: "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!"

Prayer: *God of the mountaintop, draw us into wonder and awe at the miracles you work in front of our eyes. When it is time to go back down the mountain into the ordinary, help us continue to watch for you in the things we see and hear but do not yet fully understand. Amen.*

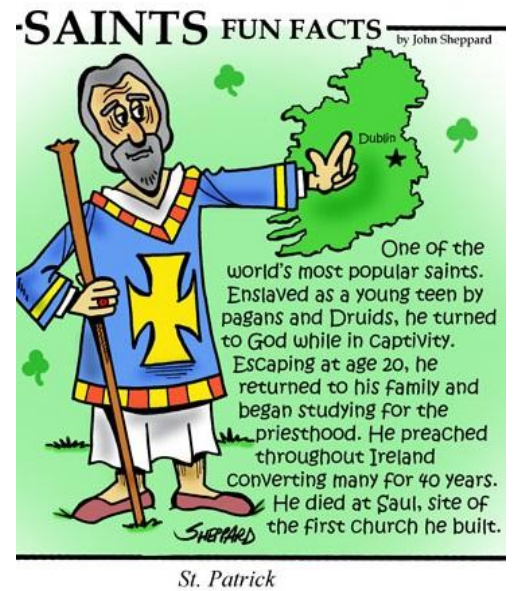

Where, in your life right now, is God still mystery?

Right in the middle of an ordinary day following Jesus, Peter, James and John follow Him up a mountain and they witness Him transfigured and talking with Elijah and Moses. [Luke 9]. The disciples want to set up camp. Jesus has to remind them they are being called back down the mountain. How often do we crave the mountaintop and expect that these moments should be our normal? How often do we want everything in life to make complete sense right now?

So much of abundant life in God requires us to marvel at the mystery of the mountaintop moments, and then hold the mystery as we walk back into the ordinary. Take some time to name, or even write down, some of the mystery God is revealing in your life. Wonder at it, find yourself in awe, and then let the awe carry you back into your life, with reverence.

This Lent, as part of the implementation of our Archdiocesan Synod, we are invited to connect with family and friends in a very special way using *Lectio Divina* or "Breaking open the Word." This ancient method of praying with sacred texts dates to the fourth century. The four simple steps of *Lectio Divina*: reading, meditation, prayer and contemplation take about 20 minutes.

LECTIO DIVINA MADE SIMPLE FOR SMALL GROUPS WITH THE PARISH

Lectio Made Simple For Small Groups with the Parish

- Create a welcoming environment and settle comfortably.
- Invite the group to listen deeply, use their imagination and to listen for a word or image that stands out as Sunday's gospel is read 2 or 3 times slowly. (if it is a long Gospel passage, choose a portion or selected verses for reflection.)
- Invite the group to deepen their consideration of the word or image that stood out. Consider what this image or word means for you and how it is important right now.
- Invite the group to share briefly any new insights or meaningful experiences. Listen to each other without comments or interrupting. Close with the Our Father. Share some hospitality.
