Third Sunday of Lent, Year C, 24 March 2019

Reading 1: Exodus 3.1-8a, 13-15; Psalm 103.1-2, 3-4, 6-7, 8+11 [R.8a]

Reading 2: 1 Corinthians 10.1-6, 10-12; Gospel: Luke 13.1-9

CCC Paragraph 755: The Church is a *cultivated field*, the tillage of God. On that land the ancient olive tree grows whose holy roots were the prophets and in which the reconciliation of Jews and Gentiles has been brought about and will be brought about again. That land, like a choice vineyard, has been planted by the heavenly cultivator. Yet the true vine is Christ who gives life and fruitfulness to the branches, that is, to us, who through the Church remain in Christ, without whom we can do nothing. [LG, Lumen Gentium 6; John 15:1-5].

Prayer: *Gardening God, tend to our roots and branches, offering water and sunshine as we need them. Help us to respond with grace to your pruning and weeding. Teach us to yearn for the light that makes us grow. Amen.*

An Examination of Conscience For Young People Before Confession

Responsibilities to God:

- Have I prayed every day?
- Have I prayed my morning prayers and night prayers?
- Have I prayed with my parents and family?
- Have I been moody and rebellious about praying and going to church on Saturday / Sunday?
- Have I asked the Holy Spirit to help me whenever I have been tempted to sin?
- Have I asked the Holy Spirit to help me do what is right?

Responsibilities to others:

- Have I been obedient and respectful to my parents?
- Have I lied or been deceitful to them or to others?
- Have I been arrogant, stubborn or rebellious?
- Have I talked back to parents, teachers or other adults?
- Have I pouted and been moody?
- Have I been selfish toward my parents, brothers, and sisters, teachers, or my friends and schoolmates?
- Have I gotten angry at them? Have I hit anyone?
- Have I held grudges or not forgiven others?
- Have I treated other children with respect or have I made fun of them and called them names?
- Have I used bad language?
- Have I stolen anything? Have I returned it?
- Have I performed my responsibilities, such as homework and household chores?
- Have I been helpful and affectionate toward my family?
- Have I been kind and generous with my friends?



How to Confess

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say: ***"Bless me Father, for I have sinned. My last confession was..."***
2. Say the sins you remember. Following your confession of sins, say: ***"I am sorry for these and all of my sins."***
3. The priest assigns you a penance such as 'action to do' or 'prayer to pray'.
4. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for your sins.

The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.

Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In His Name, my God, have mercy. Amen.
