### New life is confusing...and amazing, usually in that order.

Sometimes we preach the Resurrection too quickly. After the pain and loss of Good Friday, the waiting of Holy Saturday, all of the Gospel readings depict disciples who are first confused and perplexed. [Luke 24]. This is completely normal, because the weight and inertia of loss are more layers of loss. New life comes in ways we cannot anticipate or fully understand from the depth of grief. We can often see it only in hindsight, after the miracle of it shocks us! And so, as we go out as witnesses to Jesus' Resurrection, we can expect others might be confused before they are amazed. We can be patient with their shock, and gentle with our invitations to see and recognize miracles. We can be people who proclaim good news even when that feels confusing. Attendees will be asked to bring baby food to give to Winnipeg Harvest. People will be reminded to check the expiry date.

**Collection of plastics at all diocesan conventions. BAG-UP MANITOBA:** the CWL Manitoba Provincial Council has asked us to also collect plastic items. It is from [Multi-Material Stewardship Manitoba] MMSM's Bag Up Manitoba Schools where children collect plastics and then they are sent to Ontario to make recycled park benches, planters, birdhouses and feeders. Those items accepted are retail bags, newspaper sleeves, produce bags, bread bags, ice bags, bubble wrap, pellet bags, salt bags, dry cleaning bags, re-sealable food bags (Ziploc), cereal bags, bags from toilet paper or paper towels, bags from cases of pop, potato chip and candy bags. Items not accepted are pet food bags, bags or wrap from meat, soiled bags.
