On April 20, 2020 the Government of Manitoba announced that the provincial Covid- 19 State of Emergency will be in place for another 30 days now ending May 18, 2020.

Following this announcement, and in consultation with the Catholic bishops of Manitoba, and the deans of the Archdiocese, we have determined that the public celebration of Mass will continue to be suspended until May 18, 2020.
