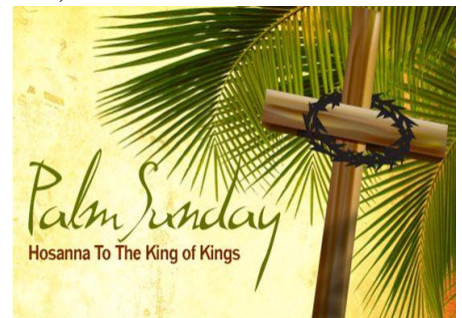

- a). for St. Anthony of Padua, on **Holy Thursday (April 9), between 5:00 - 6:00 PM**. Practicing physical distancing (6 feet apart) please go to the front door and someone will hand you over a package of Blessed Palms.
- b). for Our Lady of Lourdes, on **Good Friday (April 10), between 3:00 - 4:00 PM**. Practicing physical distancing (6 feet apart) please go to the front door & pick up a package of Blessed Palms inside the tote box on a provided table.

**BLESSINGS OF THE EASTER FOOD (BASKETS):** If circumstances permit, there will be blessings of the Easter Food (Baskets) on **Easter Sunday (April 12)** inside our 2 churches' parking lots:

- a). for Our Lady of Lourdes, **between 9:00-10:00 AM**.
- b). for St. Anthony of Padua, **between 12:00 noon - 1:00 PM**.

Please stay in your car, and when Father goes to each car, 6 ft. away, to bless your Easter Food (Basket), please roll down your car window.

As everyone is aware the Province of Manitoba is requesting that all non-critical services shut down to slow the spread of COVID- 19. Currently this shut down will be from April 1 – April 14, 2020.

In keeping with this request the Catholic Centre will be closed effective today at 3:00 pm until 10:00 am on April 14. While the physical building will be closed, Catholic Centre staff will continue to work from home. We will answer emails and be available for 'phone calls between 10:00 am – 3:00 pm during the week.
