MEMORANDUM, Archbishop Richard Gagnon, 23 July 2020. Re: New Provincial Guidelines for Faith Groups

As you have, no doubt heard, the Provincial Government is seeking to ease restrictions for faith-based gatherings. The new guidelines state that site capacity will *"be a maximum of 30% or 500 people, whichever is lower"*. The guidelines go on to state that physical distancing of at least two meters must be maintained. The guidelines also state that physical distancing between individuals, between households or between groups travelling to the event together will continue to be required. The restrictions related to singing in choirs will continue as well.

This change does not apply to social gatherings, weddings and funerals, or other organized gathering or events.

Note: *Please look carefully at your church's physical capacity to see if you are able to increase your numbers.*

These Provincial Guidelines are to come into effect on July 25, 2020.
