Abortion (and persecution) is a fear response to God's plan for life being different from our plan.

When Jesus proclaims He is the Messiah, the people of His hometown drive Him out of town and intend to kill Him. [Luke 4]. It is a fascinating parallel to the first reading from Jeremiah, which proclaims how God has a plan for His people in their mothers' wombs. [Jeremiah 1]. For Jeremiah's people, this prenatal plan is meant to inspire courage for a prophet to speak words that others find difficult to hear. Isn't it interesting that Jesus' community also struggles with this, to the point they would have killed Him? They are afraid and cannot see a way to trust that God's plan is bigger and better than theirs.

We believe every single person, from the moment of conception, is created with a purpose and a plan. That means we are called to wrap support and hope around mothers (and fathers and babies) regardless of the circumstances of conception. It also means that people we disagree with are also part of God's plan, and that hatred, violence, and condemnation are affronts to the dignity of human life. The radical truth of our faith is that no amount of disagreement, discomfort or fear justifies violence or taking another's life.

Reverend Christian Soeterboek passes away at the age of 91.

Re: Kind Prayers

Your kind prayers are requested for the repose of the soul of **Reverend Christian Soeterboek**, who passed away earlier today at the age of 91.

A priest of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg for over 63 years, Fr. Chris was born in Bakel, Netherlands on June 30, 1927. After completing his seminary formation at St. Peter's Seminary in London, Ontario, Fr. Chris was ordained to the Priesthood on June 4, 1955 in St. Mary's Cathedral.

Fr. Chris served a number of parishes throughout the Archdiocese including: Parochial Vicar of St. Edward's Parish in Winnipeg (1956-1960), (during part of this time Fr. Chris was also the Diocesan Director of Sodalitys), Chaplain of Fort Churchill (1960-1961), Administrator of St. John's Parish in Portage la Prairie (1961), Parochial Vicar of St. Edward's Parish in Winnipeg (1961-1962), Pastor of St. Theresa's Parish in Plumas (1962-67), Pastor of Corpus Christi Parish in Winnipegosis (1967-1971), Parochial Vicar of St. Edward's Parish in Winnipeg (1971-1972), Pastor of St. Joseph the Worker Parish in Russell (1972-1974), Pastor of John's Parish in Portage la Prairie (1974-1981), Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish in Virden (with attached missions) (1981-1983), Pastor of St. Viator's Parish in Dauphin (1983-1989), Pastor of St. Dominic's Parish in Neepawa (with attached missions) (1989-1992), Pastor of Our Lady of Seven Sorrows Parish in Camperville (with attached missions) (1992-1995), Parochial Vicar of St. Augustine of Canterbury Parish in Brandon (1995-1997). In addition to these parish responsibilities, Fr. Chris served as a Judge in the Regina Regional Marriage Tribunal for many years and as Dean of the Dauphin Deanery.

While Fr. Chris retired from active ministry in 1997, he continued to replace in parishes in the Westman deanery, including a brief period as Parochial Administrator of St. Dominic's Parish in Neepawa, and as Sacramental Minister of St. Jude's Parish in Erickson (with attached missions).

Funeral arrangements are as follows: Vigil Prayers on Tuesday, February 5 at 7:00 pm at Clarke Funeral Chapel, Gladstone. Funeral Mass will be celebrated on Wednesday, February 6 at 11:00 am at St. Dominic's Parish in Neepawa. Interment will take place in the Plumas Cemetery.
