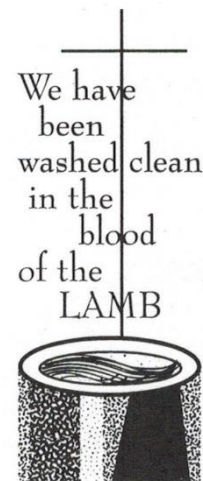

A Memorial Mass will be celebrated for the repose of the soul of Archbishop Adam Exner, OMI on Thursday, October 5 at 12:10pm at St. Mary's Cathedral. Archbishop Exner served as the Archbishop of Winnipeg from 1982-1991.

They had been praying for him all night. Ron Lee Davis, in his book, *A Forgiving God in an Unforgiving World*, tells about a moment when God's remarkable spirit of forgiveness became real to him. His best friend Jim had been hit and killed while out riding a motorcycle. The driver of the car, Mr. Smith, simply hadn't seen Jim in time and had plowed right into him. As Ron drove to visit Jim's parents, he struggled with anger against Mr. Smith. He was amazed to discover, however, that Jim's family felt only compassion for the man who had accidentally killed their son. In fact, the first question they asked when Ron walked through the door was, "Do you know how Mr. Smith is doing?"
