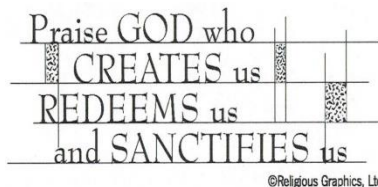

Memorandum by Archbishop Richard Gagnon, 14 May 2024, Re: Personnel

Further to the announcement made on May 3, 2024, the following Personnel appointments will take place this summer.

Due to temporary personnel shortages, Reverend Vijay Deivanayagam becomes Parochial Administrator pro tem of Immaculate Conception Parish, Fisher Branch, Holy Cross, Ashern, and St. Paul Neri, Arborg. Fr. Vijay will reside in Fisher Branch. At the same time, Fr. Vijay will continue as Pastoral Administrator of Christ the King Parish, Stonewall, St. Joseph's, Stony Mountain, and St. John Vianney, Teulon. Sacramental services will be provided by a rotation of clergy. (August 1, 2024)

Reverend Christopher Pugh (to be ordained June 28, 2024 becomes Parochial Vicar of St. Vital Parish, Winnipeg. (July 1, 2024)

St. Anthony's Confirmation on Sunday, July 21, 2024, 11:00am. Parents of the Confirmation Candidates please submit a copy of the Baptismal Certificate of your son/daughter to Fr. Dado. Thank you.

Catechism of the Catholic Church: *Candidates for Confirmation, as for Baptism, fittingly seek the spiritual help of a sponsor. To emphasize the unity of the two sacraments, it is appropriate that this be one of the baptismal godparents. (CCC 1311).*

The **Confirmation Sponsor** must be a practicing Catholic. Besides your parents, the church prefers that the godparents at baptism serve again as the sponsor at confirmation. You may choose as your sponsor, your brother, sister, godfather, godmother, aunt, uncle, cousin, friend, or neighbor who meets these requirements.

“But the machine can’t ask me about my arthritis.” This true story is told of a woman named Mamie who made frequent trips to the branch post office. One day she confronted a long line of people who were waiting for service from the postal clerk. Mamie only needed stamps, so a helpful observer asked her, *“Why don’t you just use the stamp machine? You can get all the stamps you need and you won’t have to wait in line.”* Mamie said, *“I know, but the machine can’t ask me about my arthritis.”* — That’s part of the wisdom of Christ’s coming to our earth to live among us as described in John’s Gospel (Jn 3: 16-18). He can relate to us in all of our daily needs. As we try to walk in Jesus’ steps, we might do well to pray the ancient Irish poem set to an Irish ballad tune, which says, *Be Thou my Wisdom, and Thou my true Word; I ever with Thee and Thou with me, Lord; Heart of my own heart, whatever befall, Still be my Vision, O Ruler of all.* (Fr.
