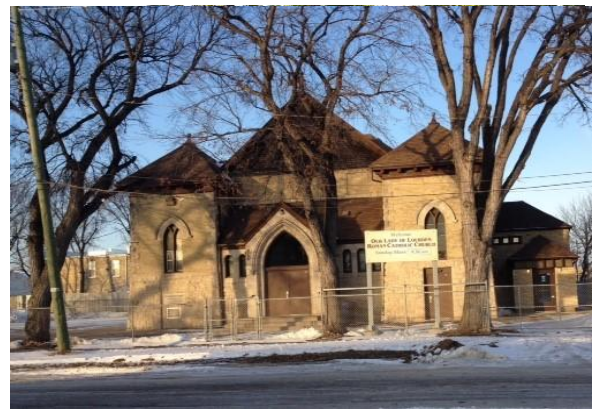

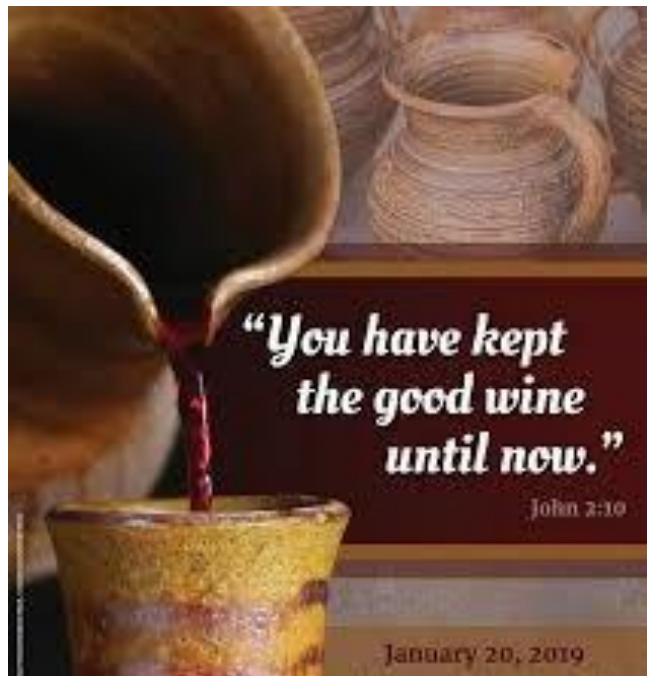
Appointment of new Parochial Vicar for Immaculate Conception Parish in Winnipeg
