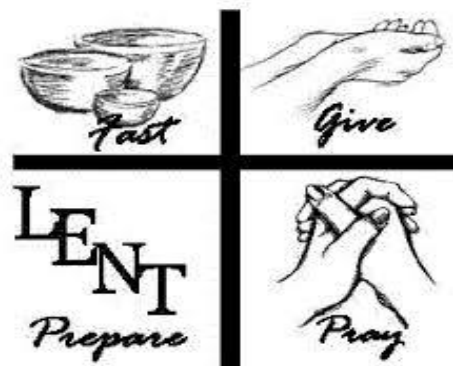

First Sunday of Lent, Year C, 10 March 2019

Reading 1: Deuteronomy 26.4-10; Psalm 91.1-2, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15 [R.15b]

Reading 2: Romans 10.8-13; Gospel: Luke 4.1-13

CCC Paragraph 1438: *The seasons and days of penance* in the course of the liturgical year (Lent, and each Friday in memory of the death of the Lord) are intense moments of the Church's penitential practice. These times are particularly appropriate for spiritual exercises, penitential liturgies, pilgrimages as signs of penance, voluntary self-denial such as fasting and almsgiving, and fraternal sharing (charitable and missionary works).

Prayer: *God, Giver of the Gift of Life, help us to open the gifts you give to us and to offer them back to you. Just as you multiplied the loaves and fishes, multiply the ordinary moments we give back to you, that we might see the miracles you work with our lives. What, in your life right now, are you offering back to God?

It is fitting, at the beginning of Lent, that Moses invites us to see our very lives as a gift offered to us by God. [Deuteronomy 26]. We are opening this gift, moment by moment, each and every day. So what are you doing with it? Leaving it unopened, re-gifting it to someone else, tearing through the paper only to be disappointed and stuff it under your bed? Moses makes an important suggestion: what if you offered it back to God? Today, and this week, what could you receive as gift and offer back to God for Him to bless? Maybe your work or your attitude, your loved ones or your frustrations, your rest or your exhaustion? How would your life change if you offered it back to God?

Archdiocese of Winnipeg Synod Implementation

Global Initiative #3

“We encourage all the baptized to acquire familiarity with Sacred Scripture”

This Lent, as part of the implementation of our Archdiocesan Synod, we are invited to connect with family and friends in a very special way using *Lectio Divina* or “Breaking open the Word.” This ancient method of praying with sacred texts dates to the fourth century. The four simple steps of *Lectio Divina*: reading, meditation, prayer and contemplation take about 20 minutes.

Lectio Made Simple For Families

- Settle in a cozy spot.
- Read the Sunday Gospel, slowly, 2 or even 3 times. (encourage children to use their imagination – can you see yourself in the story?)
- One of the following questions can be discussed after each reading of the scripture passage. (allow everyone an opportunity to speak)
- Encourage a response. “What did you like in the story?”
- God speaks to us through this story. “What do you think God is saying?” Listen deeply.
- “What might God be asking you to do?”
- Close with the Our Father. Share a healthy treat.

Lectio Made Simple For Small Groups with the Parish

- Create a welcoming environment and settle comfortably.
- Invite the group to listen deeply, use their imagination and to listen for a word or image that stands out as Sunday's gospel is read 2 or 3 times slowly. (if it is a long Gospel passage, choose a portion or selected verses for reflection.
- Invite the group to deepen their consideration of the word or image that stood out. Consider what this image or word means for you and how it is important right now.
- Invite the group to share briefly any new insights or meaningful experiences. Listen to each other without comments or interrupting. Close with the Our Father. Share some hospitality.
