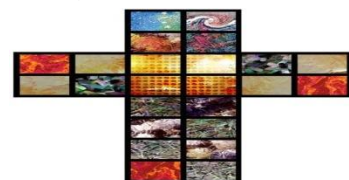

Archbishop Richard Gagnon's Memorandum: 27 March 2020

Re: Holy Week Celebrations

Palm Sunday - 5 April 2020: Mass from St. Mary's Cathedral will be live-streamed beginning at 11:00 am on our Archdiocesan Website: www.archwinnipeg.ca [For those parishes who have palms, priest may bless them and make them available at a later date.]

The Mass of the Lord's Supper - 9 April 2020 [Holy Thursday]: Mass from St. Mary's Cathedral will be live-streamed beginning at 7:30 pm on our Archdiocesan Website: www.archwinnipeg.ca [At parish churches, priests are permitted to celebrate privately the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. The faculty to celebrate this Mass without the people is granted in an exceptional manner by the Holy See to all Priests.]

Good Friday - 10 April 2020: The Service from St. Mary's Cathedral will be live-streamed beginning at 3:00 pm on our Archdiocesan Website: www.archwinnipeg.ca [Priests who are unable to celebrate the Passion should instead pray Vespers of the day.]

The Easter Vigil - 11 April 2020 [Holy Saturday]: The celebration of the Easter Vigil from St. Mary's Cathedral will be live-streamed beginning at 8:00 pm on our Archdiocesan Website: www.archwinnipeg.ca [Priests who are unable to celebrate the Vigil should instead pray the Office of the Readings.] [Parishes may wish to encourage their parishioners to mark the celebration of the Vigil by placing a lighted candle in their windows or ringing bells during their household's Easter celebration.]

Easter Sunday - 12 April 2020: The Mass of Easter Sunday from St. Mary's Cathedral will be live-streamed beginning at 11:00 am on our Archdiocesan Website: www.archwinnipeg.ca [Priests are to celebrate, privately, the Mass for Easter Sunday. Special prayers are to be said for those affected by the current pandemic, for our religious and government leaders, for our parishioners and for the dead.]

N.B.: The Mass of Christm will be celebrated at a later date.
