A few times in the Sunday readings during Easter, the first readings have recounted the stories of the struggles of the early Church, while the Gospel offers us wisdom from Jesus before His passion. This Sunday's Gospel promise is that the Spirit will be with us when Jesus is not, to bring us peace. [John 14]. In the first reading, after an extensive conflict between the Jews and Gentiles over circumcision, Peter and Paul are led by the Spirit to a resolution for the whole Church. [Acts 15].

Current conflicts in the Church (including kneeling or standing, how to handle the sex abuse crisis, or any number of other contentious issues) are not outside of this promise Jesus has made. The Spirit is with us right in the middle of the controversy. We need not let our hearts be troubled or afraid. Peace is possible now and throughout time, as the Spirit leads us through the concerns of our day.
