MEMORANDUM FROM ARCHBISHOP RICHARD GAGNON, Dated: December 17, 2021 RE: TIGHTENED RESTRICTIONS

Today, the Government of Manitoba announced tightened public health restrictions which apply throughout the province. Effective Tuesday, December 21, 2021, faith-based gatherings, including the Celebration of Mass, are permitted for up to 25% of the capacity of the space or twenty-five (25) people, whichever is lower. The presider, one (1) cantor, one (1) accompanist, one (1) lector, and the live-streaming team, do not count toward the restrictions.

The Celebrations of Weddings, Funerals, and Baptisms are allowed up to a maximum of twenty-five (25) attendees or 25% of the capacity of the building, whichever is lower. The presider, one (1) cantor, one (1) accompanist, one (1) lector, and the live-streaming team, do not count toward the restrictions. In addition, in the case of weddings, one (1) photographer or videographer does not count toward the restrictions; and in the case of funerals, the funeral home staff do not count toward the restrictions.

At St. Anthony's, the Christmas Eve 5:00pm Mass, Dec. 24th, and the Christmas Day 11:00am Mass, Dec. 25th, will be **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS ONLY**, for the 25 attendees, following the above **TIGHTENED RESTRICTIONS**. Apologies for the inconvenience.
