PRAYER FOR HEALING OVER RESIDENTIAL SCHOOLS

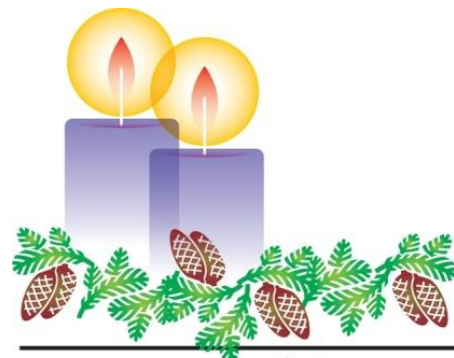
