ARCHBISHOP'S MEMORANDUM, 18 June 2021

Re: Canada's National Indigenous Peoples Day - Prayers for Reconciliation

Canada's National Indigenous Peoples Day

Monday, June 21, 2021, is Canada's National Indigenous Peoples Day. This day celebrates the distinct cultures and unique traditions of Indigenous communities. Three Indigenous peoples groups exist in Canada: the Inuit, First Nations and Metis. As a local church, we want to honour this day with a profound commitment to renewing and strengthening relationships with our Indigenous brothers and sisters.

This year, especially in light of the former Kamloops Residential School, I am suggesting that at Masses on June 21 one of the Eucharistic Prayers (with its proper Preface) for Reconciliation be prayed for the intention of reconciliation with our Indigenous brothers and sisters and for a commitment to strengthening our relationships. In fact, when possible, one of the Eucharist Prayers for Reconciliation could be prayed at weekday Masses for the remainder of the month of June. I would also encourage the use of the intention and the prayer for Indigenous peoples, sent to you earlier this month, to be continued as well.
