The Province of Manitoba has published its final public health orders. *"Manitoba Health reminds Manitobans that public health orders requiring mask-wearing in public places ends at 12:0a a.m. on Tuesday, March 15. However, masks will continue to be required for all individuals attending health-care facility, including visitors. Throughout the province, individuals may continue to choose to wear masks in various settings based on their preference, personal risk or other reasons."* [News Release, March 14, 2022, Government of Manitoba].
